

# Guiding author license choice

OUP offers two options for institutions/consortia with a Read and Publish agreement to guide author license choice.

1. Recommended license functionality
2. Restricted license functionality

## **Option 1 – Recommended license functionality**

This option allows the consortium to indicate the license that they prefer their authors choose (from the range of Creative Commons licenses offered by OUP journals).

For example, if the preference is for authors to choose the Creative Commons Attribution (CC BY) license, the system can be configured to show this as the recommended license to eligible authors when they come to agree to the terms of their license to publish. This recommendation will not appear if the journal does not offer that particular CC license.

The licensing screen, when recommended licensing functionality is enabled, would appear to authors as below:
